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CPFI HEALTH CARE ASSISTANCE

1. What is CPFI Health Care Assistance?

- (a) The CPFI Health Care Assistance is an annual benefit open to all members of the Fund with at least one year of membership in the total amount of Php1,500.00 (effective January 2018) which consists of the following:
 - i. Annual diagnostic and/or laboratory examinations or services for a total service fee with at least PhP400.00.
 - ii. Upon submission of the receipt for the laboratory examination or service fee, the member is automatically entitled to payment of PhP1,100.00 to cover for the incidental expenses such as consultation fee, etc.
 - iii. This assistance is over and above the existing Sickness Benefit being provided to the members of the Fund.

2. How can a member avail of the benefit?

- (a) A member can submit to the commonly conducted laboratory examinations but not limited to the following:

FBS (Fasting Blood Sugar)	CBC
Uric Acid (Arthritis)	ECG
Triglycerides (Heart)	X-ray
Creatinine (Kidneys)	Ultrasound
HDL/LDL (Good/Bad Cholesterol)	Pap Smear
Urinalysis	Transvaginal
Fecalalysis	Prostate Test

- (b) Eye check-up/service
- (c) Dental and Derma services (effective February 2013)

3. Where can a member submit for laboratory examination?

- (a) He/she can undergo laboratory examinations at any hospital or DOH accredited diagnostic laboratory clinics.
- (b) The Regional/Provincial Offices may contact hospitals or DOH accredited diagnostic laboratory clinics to be able avail of discounts/packages.
- (c) Members from the Central Office will be advised on the clinic where they can go for examination and be able to avail of the discounted package.

4. How will the laboratory examinations or other services be paid?

- (a) After undergoing any of the services mentioned above, the members have to pay first the service fee and should forward the original copy of the Official Receipt/s and photocopy of the laboratory result/s or Doctor's Certificate (optional) to the CPFJ within three (3) months from date of the examination.
- (b) Members are encouraged to undergo laboratory examinations simultaneously, if possible, and to consolidate receipts/supporting documents for submission by batch to the CPFJ.
- (c) Arrangements may be made with any of the hospitals/laboratory clinics for charge account, subject for approval of the Board of Trustees.
- (d) Payment shall be released to the LBP payroll or savings account of the member.

5. When is the effectivity date of the implementation of the Health Care Assistance?

- (a) This Health Care Assistance must be availed of once within the year, starting July 2006, otherwise, privilege is forfeited.
