Republic Act 8425 of 1997 (Social Reform & Poverty Alleviation Act)

defines Poor as "Individuals and families whose income fall below the poverty threshold as defined by the NEDA and/or cannot afford in a sustained manner to provide their minimum basic needs of food, health, education, housing and other essential amenities of life." (Section 3 of the RA 8425)

POVERTY THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food and non-food requirements, also known as the POVERTY LINE.

POVERTY INCIDENCE

is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Poverty Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.

AMONG POPULATION



An individual needed at least **PhP 1,996** on average, monthly to meet his/her basic food and non-food needs in 2018.



19.6% of individuals were poor in 2018, which translates to **118** thousand poor individuals.

AMONG FAMILIES



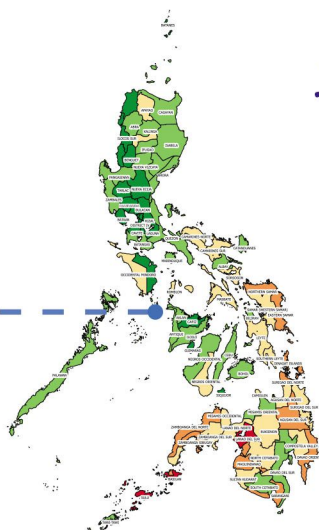
In 2018, a family in Antique with five members needed around **PhP 9,980** on average, monthly to meet their basic food and non-food needs.



13.2% of families were poor in 2018, which translates to **18.2** thousand poor families.

FOOD THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food needs, which satisfies the nutritional requirements for economically necessary and socially desirable physical activities.

SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE

The proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Food Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.

AMONG POPULATION



5.5% individuals in 2018 were not able to meet their basic food needs.

In 2018, an individual needed at least **PhP 1,394** on average, monthly to meet their basic food needs.



33.2 thousand individuals were food poor in 2018.

AMONG FAMILIES



3.2% of families in Antique did not have sufficient income to meet their basic food needs in 2018.

In 2018, a family of five needed at least **PhP 6,968** on average, monthly to meet their basic food needs.



4.4 thousand families in Antique were food poor in 2018.
